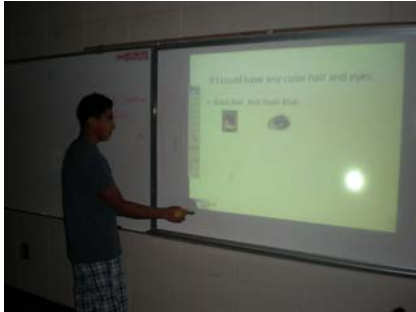

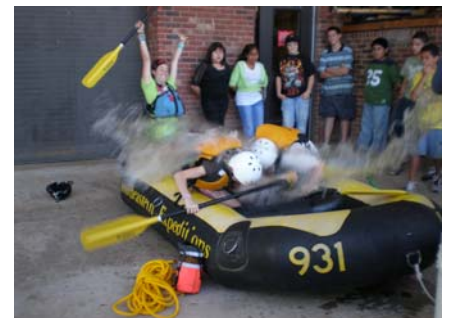


RAFT GUIDES SOAK SUMMER SCHOOL STUDENTS

The kitchen is open! We made peanut butter cookies, which were very delicious.

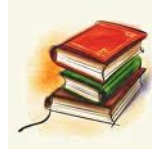


We also made deviled eggs and they were okay. We learned how to make sweet tea which was refreshing on a hot day.
